

Why did the UN end the arms embargo on Central African Republic?

UNITED NATIONS (AP) -- The U.N. Security Council on Tuesday formally ended an arms embargo on the Central African Republic, a largely symbolic move but one that was welcomed by the country's government as a sign of confidence as it seeks to end more than a decade of intercommunal conflict.

What does the UN resolution say about armed groups in Central Africa?

The resolution continues to tell all U.N. member countries to prevent arms sales to "armed groups and associated individuals" operating in the Central African Republic, including those that commit or plan attacks which "undermine efforts for a return to peace and violate international humanitarian law."

What happened to the Central African Republic after Bokassa?

After BOKASSA's departure, the country's name once again became the Central African Republic. CAR's fifth coup in 2013 unseated President Francois BOZIZE after the Seleka, a mainly Muslim rebel coalition, seized the capital and forced BOZIZE to flee the country.

What is Central African Republic known for?

The Central African Republic occupies an immense rolling plateau that forms, along a crest that trends southwest to northeast, the major drainage divide between the Lake Chad and Congo River basins. The country is well supplied with waterways. Tributaries of the Chari River occupy the northern third of the country's territory.

Why are the Russians recalibrating their Africa operations?

In the wake of Prigozhin's rebellion and suspicious death in a plane crash, the Russians are recalibrating their Africa operations. The United States, which has been largely disengaged from the region for years, is attempting to maintain a presence and stymie Russian gains as it pushes African countries to distance themselves from the mercenaries.
