

Rui Duarte Barros, who is the leader of the African Party for the Independence of Guinea and Cape Verde (PAIGC), a political party in Guinea-Bissau, served as transitional prime minister from May 2012 to July 2014 and minister of Economy and Finance in 2002. He was also commissioner of the West African Economic and Monetary Union (UEMOA).
