#### Where is Wallis & Futuna located?

Wallis and Futuna, officially the Territory of the Wallis and Futuna Islands[A][3] (/ 'w?l?s ... fu:'tu:n? /), is a French island collectivity in the South Pacific, situated between Tuvalu to the northwest, Fiji to the southwest, Tonga to the southeast, Samoa to the east, and Tokelau to the northeast. Mata Utu is its capital and largest city.

#### Does Wallis & Futuna attract tourism?

Wallis and Futuna attracts a limited amount of tourism. There is an international airport at Hihifo,northern Uvea,that is linked to French Polynesia and New Caledonia. Flights operate between Uvea and Futuna islands. A cargo vessel travels between the islands and Nouméa,New Caledonia,about a dozen times a year.

#### Who inhabited Wallis & Futuna?

The earliest inhabitants in Wallis and Futuna were people of the Lapita culture, who had reached the islands by at least 800 bce. Archaeological evidence indicates that the people engaged in agriculture and fishing. Later waves of other Polynesian sailors reached the islands about 1400 ce: Samoans settled on Futuna, and Tongans on Uvea.

#### Why did Wallis & Futuna win a weed control prize?

Wallis and Futuna was awarded the prize in 2021 following success in managing invasive weeds and animals with very limited support due to travel restrictions imposed by the COVID-19 pandemic.

#### Why are Uvea and Futuna Islands a poor place to live?

The soils of Uvea and Futuna islands are of limited fertility, and a number of factors restrict agricultural production. Only about one-fourth of the available land is suitable for cultivation. The system of land tenure, which is based on customary ownership by kin groups, has resulted in a fragmentation of land parcels.

#### How did SPREP help Wallis & Futuna?

Work to build effective coordination and implementationacross the three different projects was the focus of a mission to Wallis and Futuna by SPREP in April. To help catalyse this, meetings were held with His Majesty Lavelua King of Wallis, the Vice-President of the Territorial Assembly, the Prefect and Superior Administrator of Wallis and Futuna.
