Does Antigua & Barbuda have a travel adapter?

This normally includes the use of a travel adapter, which is a device that simply allows you to plug any US electrical appliance into a foreign electrical socket. It is important to note that it does not convert the voltage or frequency. For Antigua and Barbuda, there are two associated plug types: types A and B

Can I use a charger in Antigua & Barbuda?

Chargers for iPhones, Android phones and other smartphones or cell phones are usually dual voltage, so you can use them all over the world. However, it is possible you'll need an adapter to plug the charger into a Antigua and Barbuda outlet. Antigua and Barbuda uses electrical outlets and power plugs of types A & B (see images).

Are the electrical outlets in Antigua and Barbuda the same?

Yes, the electrical outlets in Antigua and Barbuda are the same as in the United States, both countries use power plugs and electrical outlets of types A and B. However, the voltage and/or frequency used in Antigua and Barbuda is not the same as in the United States, so you may need a voltage converter.
