

What is São Tome & Príncipe known for?

São Tome and Príncipe (STP) is a small, two-island, lower-middle-income country of approximately 960 square km. Despite its size and remote location, it has a significant untapped natural wealth, including pristine rainforests with a rich and unique biodiversity, which is favorable for nature-based tourism.

Where is São Tome & Príncipe located?

São Tomé and Príncipe is an archipelago of just over 1,000 square kilometers in the Gulf of Guinea and one of the smallest economies in Africa. São Tome and Príncipe has been a multiparty, semi-presidential, democratic system since its independence, and it has been a model for the democratic transition of power in Central Africa.

São Tomé and Príncipe is a small island country composed of an archipelago located in the Gulf of Guinea of the equatorial Atlantic Ocean. The nation's main islands are São Tomé Island and Príncipe Island, for which the country is named. These are located about 300 and 250 kilometres (190 and 160 mi), respectively, off the northwest coast of Gabon in Central Africa.

São Tomé and Príncipe's neonatal mortality rate (NMR)[^] is 15 deaths per 1,000 live births.³ NMR != in rural areas is 19 deaths per 1,000 live births and 17 deaths per 1,000 live births in urban areas for an urban-to-rural ratio of 0.9. 2

The two islands of São Tomé and Príncipe, along with a few associated rocky islets, are located in the Gulf of Guinea on the southern coast of West Africa. The main islands are a mix of flat and mountainous areas of seemingly dormant volcanoes. São Tomé Peak is the highest point in the group, reaching a height of 2,024 metres (6,640 ft).
