However, there is an exemption under 1910.106(e)(2)(i) for incidental storage which allows employers to store up to 25 gallons of Category 1 and 120 gallons of Categories 2, 3, and 4 in containers in any one "fire area" of the facility outside a flammable storage cabinet or storage room. However, it is always a best practice to do so.

The correct storage of chemicals within storage areas / stock rooms, workshops and laboratories is an on-going problem which can sometimes be complex and potentially confusing. The overall purpose of correct storage is to maintain control over the chemicals so that they can be both stored and retrieved safely.
