Data shows that Wallis and Futuna's population decreased by 61 (-0.5 percent) between early 2023 and the start of 2024. 52.3 percent of Wallis and Futuna's population is female, while 47.7 percent of the population is male.

Wallis and Futuna was the only French colony to side with the Vichy regime during World War II until the arrival of Free French and US troops in 1942.
