

Is Kiribati a remote country?

Kiribati is one of the most remote and geographically dispersed countries in the world. It is composed of 33 small islands, spread across 3.5 million square kilometers of ocean.

What is Kiribati known for?

Kiribati - pronounced Kiribass - won independence from the United Kingdom in 1979. Home to the South Pacific's largest marine reserve, many of the atolls are inhabited; most of them are very low-lying and at risk from rising sea levels as a result of global warming.

Why does Kiribati need a safe and resilient transport infrastructure?

A safe and resilient transport infrastructure is essential for connecting Kiribati's population to economic opportunities and social services, particularly for those living on the outer islands. It is also a key to achieving the objective of the Government of Kiribati to stem-the-tide of migration from outer islands.

Does Kiribati have infrastructure gaps?

As a small remote economy, Kiribati suffers from significant infrastructure gaps in a number of key sectors (IMF, 2018, p. 19). However, it is clear that previous investments have not fulfilled their design potential, with serviceability and utilisation rates well below prudent levels.

Kiribati (republic of) comprises 32 atolls and reef islands and one raised coral island, Banaba dispersed over 3.5 million square kilometres of ocean. It lies north of Tuvalu, Tokelau, the Cook Islands and French Polynesia, east of Nauru, south of Hawaii and west of South America.

South Tarawa is the capital and hub of the Republic of Kiribati and home to more than half of Kiribati's population. The South Tarawa population centre consists of all the small islets from Betio in the west to Bonriki and Tanaea in the north-east, connected by the South Tarawa main road, with a population of 63,439 as of 2020.
