

What are Norfolk Island electricity services?

Norfolk Island electricity services are comprised of two main elements, the: Reticulation. Administrative, clerical and billing components are carried out by the Finance branch and are supported by other areas such as the Legal Services Unit and Customer Care.

How much does electricity cost on Norfolk Island?

Electricity tariffs on Norfolk Island are dynamic and reflect the operation of the power system each and every half hour. Residents with a time-of-use meter pay and receive the dynamic tariffs. \$0.90 per day for daily supply charge.
