

What are Pokémon Energy cards?

Pokémon Energy Cards are a vital component of the Pokémon Trading Card Game (TCG). In order to use their attacks, Pokémon must have a specified number and type (s) of Energy Card attached to it. For example: if four Water Energy are required for an attack, a player must have four blue Water Energy Cards attached to that Pokémon.

What are fighting Energy cards in Pokemon Go?

Fighting Energy Cards are Orange and are indicated by the symbol which depicts a black fist against an orange background. Fighting Energy corresponds to Fighting, Ground and Rock type Pokémon. Darkness Energy Cards are coloured dark Blue. They are indicated by the symbol of a black crescent in a dark blue circle.

What is basic fire energy?

Release information Basic Fire Energy (Japanese: ??????? Basic Fire Energy) is a Basic Energy card which provides one Fire Energy(). This can be attached to Pokémon cards and used to power moves with Fire or Colorless Energy requirements. This section contains old or outdated information, or has not been updated in a while.

Are Pokémon Energy cards valuable?

Pokémon cards first hit the North American market in January 1999. Pokémon Energy cards from the first few years can be quite valuable, especially if they have the '1st Edition' stamp. During this time, first edition cards were highly sought after.

How many Energy cards are there in Pokémon Go?

When the TCG first launched in 1999, there were 6 different Energy Cards - Grass, Fire, Water, Lightning, Psychic and Fighting. In 2006, Darkness and Metal Energy, were moved from Special Energy to Basic Energy cards. In 2013, Fairy Energy cards were introduced to coincide with the upcoming launch of Fairy Type Pokémon.

What is a grass energy card in Pokemon Go?

Grass Energy Cards are green in colour and indicated by the symbol a black leaf in a green circle. Grass Energy corresponds to Grass and Bug type Pokémon. Fire Energy Cards are red and indicated by the symbol which depicts a black flame on a red background. Fire Energy corresponds to Fire type Pokémon.
