

# Problems with new energy storage are still a concern

What are the challenges in the application of energy storage technology?

There are still many challenges in the application of energy storage technology, which have been mentioned above. In this part, the challenges are classified into four main points. First, battery energy storage system as a complete electrical equipment product is not mature and not standardised yet.

What challenges hinder energy storage system adoption?

Challenges hindering energy storage system adoption As the demand for cleaner, renewable energy grows in response to environmental concerns and increasing energy requirements, the integration of intermittent renewable sources necessitates energy storage systems (ESS) for effective utilization.

Why is energy storage a problem?

The lack of direct support for energy storage from governments, the non-announcement of confirmed needs for storage through official government sources, and the existence of incomplete and unclear processes in licensing also hurt attracting investors in the field of storage (Ugarte et al.).

What role does energy storage play in the future?

As carbon neutrality and cleaner energy transitions advance globally, more of the future's electricity will come from renewable energy sources. The higher the proportion of renewable energy sources, the more prominent the role of energy storage. A 100% PV power supply system is analysed as an example.

How has electrochemical energy storage technology changed over time?

Recent advancements in electrochemical energy storage technology, notably lithium-ion batteries, have seen progress in key technical areas, such as research and development, large-scale integration, safety measures, functional realisation, and engineering verification and large-scale application function verification has been achieved.

Why is non-acceptance of energy storage systems a problem?

Non-acceptance of EES systems by the industry can be a significant obstacle to the development and prevalence of the utilization of these systems. To generate investment in energy storage systems, extensive cooperation between facility and technology owners, utilities, investors, project developers, and insurers is required.
