

How to get to Saint-Pierre & Miquelon?

By sea or by air, it is easy to come and see us in Saint-Pierre and Miquelon! Depending on your point of departure, connections to Saint-Pierre and Miquelon take from 45 minutes to 3 hours and 15 minutes from Canada. In the summer, a connection from Paris takes you to us in 5 hours and a connection from the Magdalen Islands in 1 hour.

How much does it cost to visit Saint Pierre / Miquelon?

Between 17,50EUR and 29EUR for Saint Pierre /Miquelon. Free for children under 2,50% of the adult rate for children from 2 to 12,80% of the adult rate for teenagers from 12 to 18.
