

Where are the sunniest regions in Germany?

On closer examination, this proves to be a stubborn prejudice. The sunniest regions in Germany are located on the Baltic Sea coast. The very top performer is the little village of Zinnowitz on the island of Usedom. An average of 1,917 hours of sunshine are recorded here per year - more than in any other region.

Where are the least sunny cities in Germany?

At the other end of the scale, the five least sunny cities in Germany are all in North Rhine-Westphalia, where the sun shines on average for a mere 3,3 hours per day. If you're looking for your next vitamin D fix, it's best to avoid this part of the country!

Are Germany's sunniest cities the warmest?

There are perhaps some surprises here, as the sunniest cities in Germany aren't necessarily the warmest. In fact, the cities with the highest average temperatures are largely located in the sun-deprived western states. Offenbach am Main secures the number one spot with an average annual maximum of 15,4 degrees.
