# What is the pump in water energy storage

What is pumped hydro energy storage?

Pumped hydro energy storage is a method of storing and generating electricity by moving water between two reservoirs at different elevations. Excess power is used to pump water from the lower reservoir to the upper reservoir during off-peak periods, and the stored water is released back to generate electricity when demand increases.

How does pumped storage hydropower (PSH) work?

Pumped Storage Hydropower (PSH) works by using two reservoirs of water at different elevations. During periods of high energy production, excess energy is used to pump water up into the higher reservoir. This stored energy can then be released later to generate electricity.

What is the main source of energy for pumped hydropower storage?

Pumped hydropower storage uses the force of gravityto generate electricity using water that has been previously pumped from a lower source to an upper reservoir. The technology absorbs surplus energy at times of low demand and releases it when demand is high.

How does a pumped storage facility work?

The principle is simple. Pumped storage facilities have two water reservoirs at different elevations on a steep slope. When there is excess power on the grid and demand for electricity is low, the power is used to pump water from the lower to the upper reservoir using reversible turbines.

How does a pumped storage hydropower plant work?

When the grid needs electricity, a valve opens and the pressurized gas pushes the water through a turbine, which spins a generator. This process is part of pumped storage hydropower, a clean energy technology that can come in various sizes and is expected to last for more than 30 years.

What is the energy storage capacity of a pumped hydro facility?

The energy storage capacity of a pumped hydro facility depends on the size of its two reservoirs. At times of high demand - and higher prices - the water is then released to drive a turbine in a powerhouse and supply electricity to the grid. The amount of power generated is linked to the size of the turbine.
